The strawberry season begins approximately late June. Weather and crop permitting your class will have the option of picking their own strawberries instead of planting.



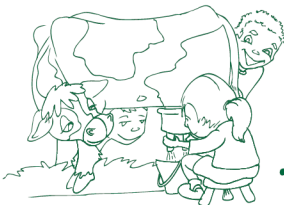
